EPITOPE SPECIFICITY The epitope is in the 9-39 region of the peptide, and the antibody cross-reacts strongly with exendin (9-39)

amide.

**PRESENTATION** 

Content: Available in 400 µL and 1 mL size.1 mg/mL +/- 15%. See Certificate of Analysis for details.

Preparation: Protein-A purified

Form: Liquid

Solvent: 0.01 M phosphate buffer, pH 7.4, containing 0.5 M NaCl and 15 mM sodium azide

Storage: 4-8°C without exposure to light. No precautions necessary during handling.

APPLICATION ELISA: ABS 012-20 binds to exendin-4 when coated on ELISA wells and reacts specifically with exendin-4

in solution giving a Ka of 1.6x10E8 in inhibition ELISA. The binding between ABS 012-20 and exendin-4 is

disrupted by 4.5 M MgCl2.

TARGET Exendin-4 is a 39 amino acid peptide found in venom from the Gila monster *Heloderma suspectum*. It is a

member of the glucagon-secretin family of peptide hormones and neuropeptides. Exendin-4 is a potent

agonist of the GLP-1 receptor and hence a potent stimulator of insulin secretion.
